

# Players information NEVZA Sweden 2019

## Important competition information

- **Before your first match** all players need to sign in with Technical Supervisor Peter Appelgren. You'll find him in the corner of CC.
- **Losing teams** will be sharing the task as scorer and 2nd referee the next match on day 1 and scoring only on day 2. Winning teams will rake the sand (day 1&2)
- **Top three teams** have mandatory attendance at the award ceremony at the end of the competition/finals on Sunday.

## Preliminary Inquiry

The team need to leave their signature to the Technical Supervisor at site before their first match.

## Courts

**Friday:** 4 competition courts, 2 warm up courts

**Saturday:** 2 competition courts, 1 warm up court

**Sunday:** 1 competition court, 1 warm up court.

**Training courts:** 2 courts are available for training on Thursday all day. Each team can book one hour together with another team on the same court. To book training in advance, send an email to [tournament@gbcbeach.com](mailto:tournament@gbcbeach.com) or sign up on site at the front desk.

**Note!** On saturday we have 2 competition courts but only 1 warm up court. Please share this respectfully between all teams that are playing the next match.

## Access and finding your way in Beach Center

All Nevza players can pick up an access tag at the front desk at the time of your arrival to Beach Center. This gives you access to the dressing rooms and Players Lounge on the second floor and the gym on the third floor. It's important that you **return the access tag at the front desk before you leave.** **There will be a fee for tags that are not returned.**

## Dressing rooms and lockers

The dressing room on the second floor has lockers for safe bag keeping. Bring your own padlock or buy one at the front desk. You can also find lockers in the common area outside dressing rooms at the first floor.

## Players Lounge

On the second floor you find the Players Lounge in the Relax area. There you may use the sauna or just chill out between the games.

## Restaurant, Beach Cuisine

The restaurant is open following hours:

Thursday	11.00-14.00 + 15.00-22.00 (no players discount between 15-22)
Friday	11.00-14.00 + 15.00-22.00
Saturday	12.00-22.00 (Buffet: 19.00-21.00, read more under Halloween Party)
Sunday	12.00-19.30

Friday-Sunday (and Thursday 11.00-14.00) the restaurant will serve three different tournament dishes. You may choose fish, meat or vegetarian. Tell the staff you're playing Nevza and you'll get a players discount and pay 65 SEK for the dish. To facilitate for the players and make sure that everyone has a place to sit players may order the food from the Beach Bar next to CC. If/when you eat in the restaurant you must wear shoes and clothes and make sure that you bring as little sand as possible into the restaurant.

## Water during matches

Bring your own water bottle and fill them up before the match starts. There are water taps to be found close to the courts.

## Match clothing

No uniforms will be provided by the organizer. Make sure your team is wearing matching uniforms with visible numbers. All players must wear the uniform during coin toss and the official warm-up.
